



CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: No 2

SI 5.2 is changed as follows:

[DP][NP][SP] Flag D with one sound means: “The warning signal will be made not less than 60 minutes after flag D is displayed”. Boats shall not leave their allocated berth until their Fleet signal has been made **or the signal no more racing today has been made ashore.**

SI 12.2 is changed as follows:

[DP][NP] Boats whose warning signal has not been made shall avoid the starting area during the starting sequence for other races. **The starting area is defined as a rectangle 50 meters from the starting line and marks in all directions**

16 PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

16.1 The wording has been changed to read:

“The protest time limit for each **FLEET is 75 minutes** after the last boat has finished their last race of the day, or the race committee signals no more racing today for that FLEET, whichever is the later. **However, the protest time limit is 30 minutes after the signal No more racing today is made ashore.**”

Add new SI 16.6:

Penalties for breaches of RRS 50 and 78.1, class rules, rules in the Notice of Race or Sailing Instructions marked '[DP]', are at the discretion of the International Jury.

Add new SI 16.7:

For breaches of a rule marked '[SP]' the Race Committee may impose a standard penalty without a hearing to the race sailed nearest in time of the incident, or a discretionary penalty may be imposed by the international jury with a hearing. The "Race Committee Standard Penalties" document shows a list of these breaches and the associated standard penalties. However, the race committee may protest a boat if it considers that a standard penalty is inappropriate. A boat that has been penalized with a standard penalty may neither be protested by another boat for the same incident nor may another boat request redress for this race committee action. This changes RRS 60.1(a) and (b), 63.1 and A5.1.

Add new SI 16.8:

In RRS 62.2(a) and 66.2(a) change 'the last scheduled day of racing' to 'the last day of the Qualifying Series or the last scheduled day of racing'.
