## 2022 29er World Championships, El Balis

### What to Expect

With the 2022 World Championships less than three weeks away, please make sure you are updated with all the latest event information below. You can also **sign up** for all the latest news and press releases before and during the event [here](#)

#### **Arrival and launching information**

In order to offer good service and assistance, we appreciate if you could inform our organization when you expect to arrive and how many boats you are bringing, at [sailing@cnelbalis.com](mailto:sailing@cnelbalis.com).

When you arrive with boats and/or coach boat, **before unloading, go to the Race Office** to register your boats, collect your coach boat identification and instructions for boat parking allocations, moorings, and crane services. This includes Coach boats who need to [register and pay online](#) before launching and then register for the event in the race office from 29<sup>th</sup> July.

The Race Office in El Balis is located on the first floor of the Sports Area facilities (blue building) and will be open:

from 18<sup>th</sup> July, 09:00 until 18:00

from 29<sup>th</sup> July, 08:30 until 18:00

**Please Note:** Boats / ribs arriving later than 19:00 hours before the 29<sup>th</sup> of July will need to wait to the next day to proceed with unloading operations.

West road access to the marina is for cars only (no vans and trailers allowed because the train bridge). **All trailers and vans need to use the main access on the East side.**

All boats will be assigned to a boat parking zone and their corresponding ramp.

Each boat will receive a label at registration with their sail number and the ramp assigned, grouped by countries. If boats arrive earlier than the registration days, the allocations will be available at the Race Office at their arrival, although the labels will be provided on the registration days. Boats must park in the assigned boat parking zone and must use the assigned ramp.

There is a dedicated and reserved car parking (only vehicles / no trailers) next to the Marina facilities with a direct pedestrian path access. Car accreditations will be available at the Race Office.

### Health regulation update

At the airport on arrival into Spain you will be asked for your third vaccination certificate. Please check the [www.spth.gob.es](http://www.spth.gob.es) for the rules that apply to your personal situation, especially if you are coming from a non-EU country.

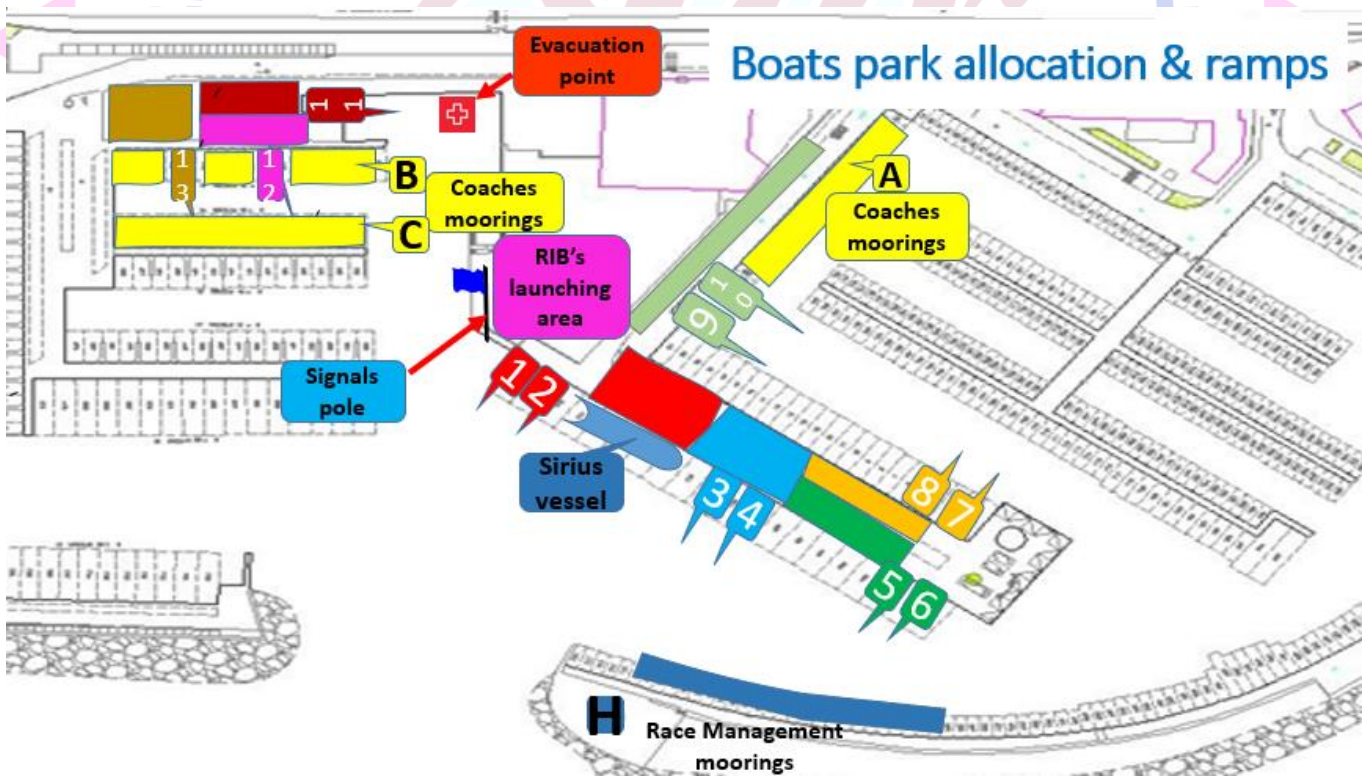
### Regatta Meals

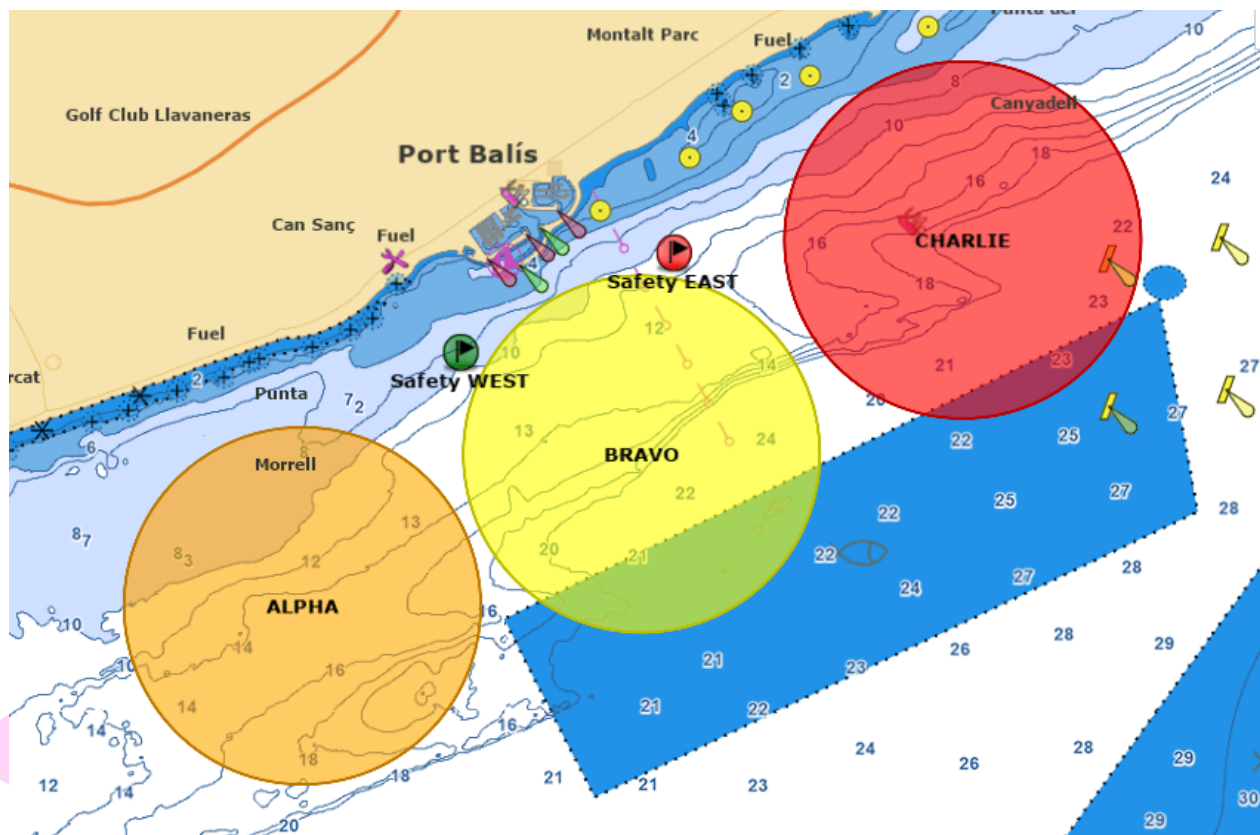
