



WHAT TO EXPECT

Early Arrivals

- Possible from July 25th

Hospitality fee 100CZK/5€ per person and day – payment at the day of arrival

Entry gate to the venue is operating 0900 – 1200 /1300 – 1800. We kindly ask you to RESPECT THESE times.

- We kindly ask you to respect the arrival and departure directions of drive. Boats can be loaded and packed inside of the boatpark, not alongside of the road – see Map.

Parking

- All vehicles are to be parked in car/ trailer parking (see Map)

- Car park is open 0700 till 2200

PARKING ALONGSIDE THE ROAD IS NOT POSSIBLE. Grass field on opposite side is private – restricted area – see attached plan.

Parking of Rib and 29er Road Trailers

- Please put road trailers on trailer parking (see Map)
- You may wish to bring a hitch or wheel lock to secure your trailer.

Support Boats & RIB Launching

If you are bringing a RIB as a coach or support boat during the event, please ensure you registered it on the event website prior to arrival and you will also have to register on site Regatta office when you arrive.

Launching of RIBs is at:

- Launching ramp or crane for the ribs are available in the club
- Operating Tue – Sun 0900-1200 and 1300-1600
- Single slipway is available in the club to launch the ribs

Petrol Station

- Location of nearest petrol station for refueling ribs is:

Rib Parking

- In the club marina on mooring, mooring spaces will be allocated upon registration depending on the water levels and slots availability in the marina

Restriction for Ribs

Due to Lipno lake is part of National park, special permit is necessary. The documents and rules are to be signed upon arrival and rib registration.

Police is doing regular checks, so having your PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION, LICENSE, INSURANCE AND ANY DOCUMENTS OR NUMBER PROVIDED BY THE ORGANIZING AUTHORITY IS MANDATORY at all times.

THERE ARE LIMITS FOR RIBS, WHICH HAS TO BE RESPECTED:

- Boat planing is prohibited, except for rescue purposes!
- Passenger vessels always have the right of way and it is necessary to avoid them (ribs and boats) in time. Any disturbances in passenger vessel cause by a rib or a boat can be subject to Police involvement.
- It is prohibited to use the passenger vessel marks for purposes of training or racing.
- Before launching, the boat must be registered with the organizer.
- The permit is issued for the period from 18 July to 9 August 2026.
- The permit is only valid for following the boats during regatta, it is strictly PROHIBITED to use the ribs for free time activities such as wake or foil towing.

Dinghy Park

Zones are divided by nations specified upon arrival to the venue.

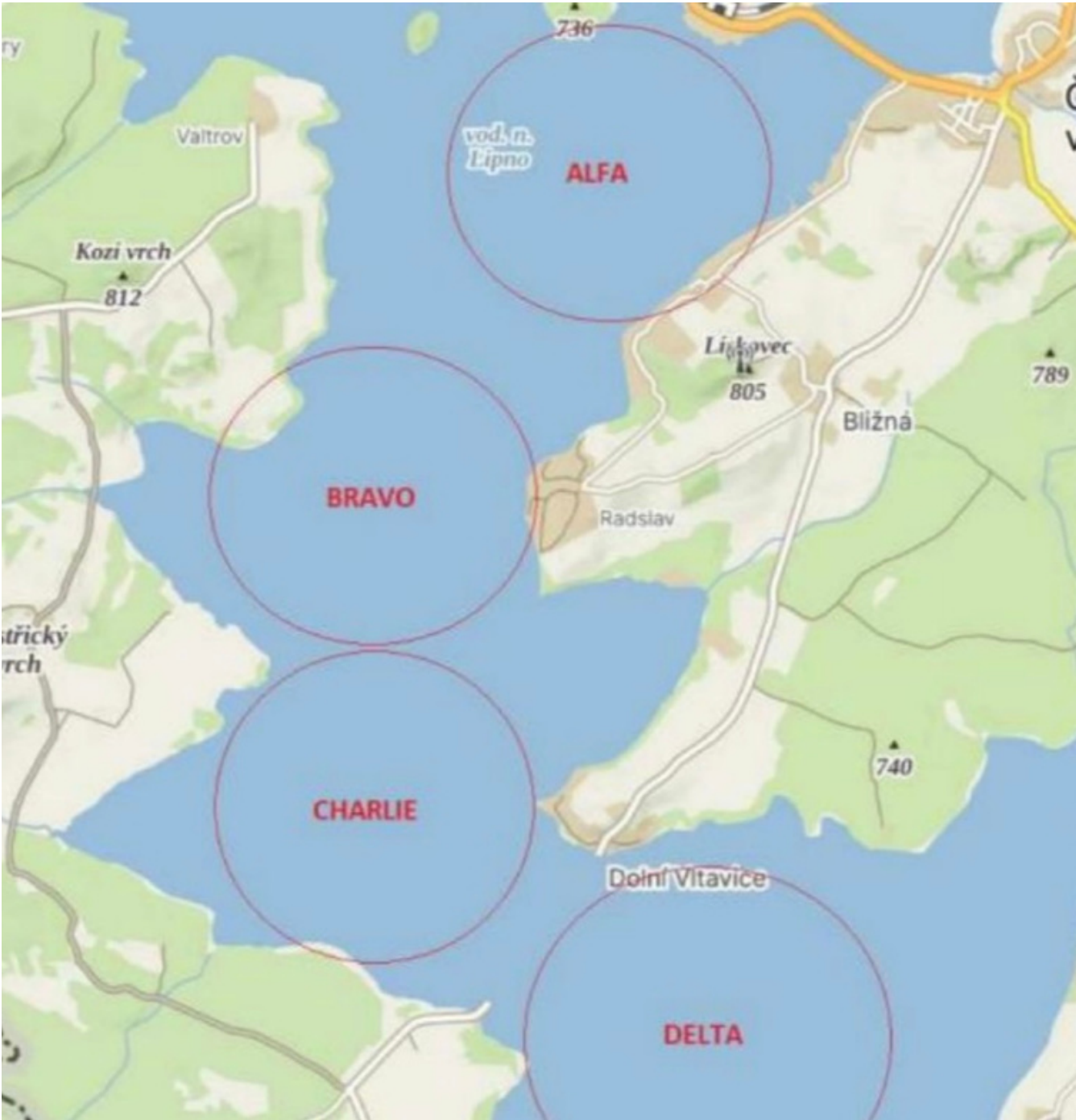
- Scooters, Skateboards, Segways etc.
